There are several hotels and B&Bs quite near the conference venue -- see below for links. [The Inn at Harvard](#) is directly across the street from the conference site and the [Hotel Veritas](#) is only two blocks away, but there are other hotel options near Harvard Square that are less expensive. It always pays to check the online travel web sites for discounts; [kayak.com](#) will let you search for rooms on Hotwire, Hotels.com, Expedia, Priceline, and Travelocity simultaneously. Also since March is definitely the off season in Boston you may be able to get better deals as the date gets nearer.

Nearby B&Bs include [Irving House](#) at Harvard, [Harding House](#), [Parkside on Ellery](#), and [A Bed & Breakfast](#) in Cambridge. One of the best deals is the [John Jeffries House](#), which is on Beacon Hill, 3 stops/10 min from Harvard Square on the MBTA Red Line subway and a short walk from our Friday night venue, the Church of the Advent.

There are also many other hotels that are just 2 or 3 stops away on the Red Line, either in Cambridge (Marriott, Kendall, [Hotel Marlowe](#), and Royal Sonesta near the Kendall-MIT stop) or just across the river in Boston (John Jeffries House, Holiday Inn and Liberty Hotel near the Charles-MGH stop). And some of the large downtown Boston hotels may offer better rates than those nearer to Harvard. If you are looking on a map, the Barker Center is at the intersection of Quincy and Harvard Streets near Mass. Ave, opposite the southeast corner of Harvard Yard in Cambridge.
