The hotel closest to Harvard Law School is the **Sheraton Commander**, a pleasant 5-10 minute, 0.2 mile walk across Cambridge Common. They are offering us a [group rate](#) of \$209/night (plus taxes and fees of approximately \$30/night), approximately 15% less than their usual online rate. This rate is subject to availability and may be withdrawn at any time if the hotel fills up, so early booking is strongly advised; check the hotel website for complete terms and conditions.

Another economical option that is popular with BPS attendees is the [John Jeffries House](#) on Beacon Hill at the Charles/MGH Red Line station, 3 stops from Harvard Square.

Other hotels near Harvard Square include the [Charles](#), [Veritas](#), [Harvard Square](#), and [Porter Square](#) hotels. It always pays to check the online travel web sites for discounts; also since March is the off season in Boston you may be able to get better deals as the date gets nearer.

Nearby B&Bs include Irving House at Harvard, Mary Prentiss Inn, Parkside on Ellery, A Bed & Breakfast in Cambridge, Harding House, and Gray House. There are also numerous Airbnb listings in the area.

If you are planning to do some sightseeing in Boston before or after the conference, there are several other hotels that are just 2 or 3 stops away on the Red Line, either in Cambridge (Marriott, Kendall, Marlowe, and Royal Sonesta near the Kendall-MIT stop) or just across the river in Boston (Wyndham and Liberty near the Charles-MGH stop). And some of the large downtown Boston and Back Bay hotels may offer better rates than those closer to Harvard.
